

Schedule Guides for Master's and Doctor's process in English Department's General Graduate School

1. General matters

1) **Studying year** : 4 semesters (2 years)

cf. Reduction of the studying year : 대이과목 이수자, 학.석사연계과정, 석.박사통합과정

Since this does not apply to most students, you can simply consider it for reference.

2) **Enrollment year maximum (cannot be exceeded)** : Master's - 4 years (8 semesters), PhD - 6 years (12 semesters).

3) **Maximum Period of Suspension of schooling** : 2 consecutive years (four semesters) & cannot exceed 3 years (six semesters).

4) **Completion credits**: Master's degree - 24 credits, PhD - 36 credits required.

2. About Credits

1) Course Registration

- ※ Academic Calendar(Course registration and correction period) : <https://www.pknu.ac.kr/main/31>

- Up to 12 credits per semester (3 credits per general course / 3 credits each for seminar/thesis research course).
- Seminar 1, Seminar 2, and thesis research courses are ought to be completed in the third and fourth semesters.
- Courses completed in Master's process cannot be repeated in PhD's process.

2) Core Subjects

① 논문연구 (Thesis Research)

-If not taken, not eligible for graduation (Must be completed in your fourth semester of study; cannot be completed in advance)

- Must be completed even if the additional 9 credits substitute for the Master's Claims Thesis
- This course is to prepare for your thesis, so be sure to contact your advisor after signing up for the course. (failure to do so may result in a grade of F).

③ Seminar

- Seminar courses are not required, but can be taken as preparation for a thesis.
- Only one course is opened under the name of the head professor of department (sometimes under the name of another professor), however, after applying, the actual course is conducted between the supervisor professor and the student. Be sure to contact your advisor after signing up for the course (failure to do so may result in a grade of F).
- Regardless of the order of seminars 1 and 2, enroll and complete courses in the 3rd and 4th semesters

(First Semester : 석사세미나1 (Master Seminar 1), 박사세미나1(PhD Seminar 1)

Second Semester : 석사세미나2 (Master Seminar 2), 박사세미나2 (PhD Seminar 2)

3. Selection of supervisor professors

- Selected immediately after final exam in the first semester. (PhD students are assigned a prospective advisor upon admission)
- You must request a meeting with the professor you want to be your advisor in person during your first semester.

4. Foreign language test and comprehensive test

① Eligibility

- Foreign Language Test : PhD Students (Not applicable for master's students)
- Comprehensive Test : Master's and PhD students who have earned at least one-half of the credits toward completion

② Test Subjects

- Foreign Language Test : 전공영어 (Major English) (2 questions Total)

- Comprehensive Test

[‘18~‘20] Master : 3 subjects, PhD : 4 subjects (2 questions per subject)

[After ‘21] Master : 2 subjects, PhD : 3 subjects (2 questions per subject)

※ You must select your specific major (literature, language, education) in at least two of the courses you have taken.

※ You can't take all of the subjects in the test with the same professor.

③ Acceptance Criteria : At least 70 points for each subject (out of 100)

④ Criteria for exam substitutions or exemptions : You only need to meet 1 of the criteria below.

▷ Exemption for Comprehensive Test (Only for Master's Degree)

: Have completed 12 or more credit hours and have a grade point average of 4.3 or higher through the immediately preceding semester (automatically exempt, no need to apply for exemption)

⑤ Test taking & Application for Substitution

- 1) When and how to apply : Apply on the portal during the designated period
- 2) Test Schedule

⑥ **Retest** : If you fail the comprehensive exam, you can change the subject you took and take it the next semester.

5. Thesis Defense

① Eligibility

- Those who have completed or are expected to complete / Those who passed foreign & Comprehensive test and have an advisor's recommendation
- Those who have published at least one paper as first author or co-author in domestic or international journals listed (nominated) by the Korea Research Foundation(한국연구재단) or higher.

② Thesis Defense Period
